

Advance Queensland - Privacy Statement

How will my personal information be managed?

By participating in the Advance Queensland (AQ) Accelerating Female Founders Program (AFFP), the provider funded under the program will collect your personal and business information to share with the Department of Environment, Science and Innovation (DESI) for the purposes of:

- milestone reporting on outcomes achieved; and
- research, review, audits, evaluation and reporting conducted by the funding agency, DESI.

The email address you provide will be used by DESI to communicate with you. You may be contacted via email about participating in surveys, interviews or focus groups for the purpose of evaluating the program. Dependent upon the email service provider you have chosen, this may result in your personal information being transferred overseas.

The personal information provided may be provided to other relevant Queensland Government departments and Ministers, to publicly announce, publish and promote those services and programs that have been funded under the AQ AFFP, such as good news stories and case studies.

De-identified aggregated data may also be used for the purpose of managing and evaluating the initiative and informing government about designing and improving future policies and programs.

Your personal information will not be otherwise used or disclosed unless authorised or required by law and will be managed in accordance with the Information Privacy Act 2009.
